We are very lucky to be owners of such a special park in a beautiful part of Florida and have the opportunity to govern our own community.

This season will hopefully be a wonderful experience for all in the park. Your Board of Directors (BOD) will be ready to help provide this experience. Also, "Thank You" to the many park volunteers who help make running a resident-owned park financially sound.

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of each month, your BOD holds a meeting for ALL SHAREHOLDERS. This means that your name is on the share. If you are living with someone whose name is on the share but yours isn't, then you cannot attend a BOD meeting or vote in any election held by the BOD. An agenda for the meeting will be posted 48 hours before the meeting on the bulletin boards at the mailboxes and in front of the Community Hall as well as inside the Lake Bonnet Hall. Following adjournment of the BOD meeting, there will immediately be an open discussion meeting where anyone attending can ask questions of the board, give opinions, make suggestions, etc. Coffee is always available. #### YEARLY BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION

The first notice of the election to fill 3 vacancies on the BOD will be sent out on 11/22/2024 and will include a copy of the proposed 2025 budget. The Budget Meeting will be held on 12/13/2024 at Lake Bonnet Hall (west). The second notice of the election will be sent out on 12/23/2024 and will include copies of candidate's

resumes, ballot, envelopes, and a proxy to vote on waving the reserves and audit. If you do not plan on attending the Shareholders meeting on the fourth Wednesday of January (22<sup>nd</sup>), this proxy needs to be returned to the office (mailed or in person) before January 22nd. The election will take place at the Lake Bonnet Hall (west) on Wednesday, January 22, 2025, at 9:00 AM.

I would like to say a BIG THANK YOU to the 2017 Board of Directors and shareholders when we were trying to get a vote to build the beautiful Lake Bonnet Hall/Shelter that served us so well during this past summer's hurricane/storms. Their foresight has created a safe haven for all of us.

#### **FRIENDLY REMINDERS:**

- 1. To ALL shareholders, renters, and their visitors: According to the State of Florida Marijuana Use Law, only people who carry a Florida issued Medical Marijuana Card are allowed to smoke marijuana and only within their residence. Therefore, your LBV Co-Op will enforce this law as well as the use of any other State of Florida established illegal drug. Our rules also prohibit ANY TYPE OF SMOKING which includes vaping, at either pool, at the laundry/bath house, the Office, in either clubhouse or any of our buildings that are for the use of our residents, AT ANY TIME.
- 2. We are looking forward to another great year from our residents in keeping their units washed, repaired and any junk removed. Redwood residents have been showing the rest of the park what that looks like. Any other areas up to challenging them for top honors? We truly appreciate all of you who help keep our park top notch.
- 3. Our Fun Club was in place when we purchased the park in 2002 and has been a vital part of the success in building a very special community and place to live. Every resident, including renters, is automatically a member of the Fun Club, the social arm of the park. We wish to thank all the people who have volunteered in some way throughout the past 22 years to make the Fun Club a terrific aspect of Lake Bonnet Village. Please volunteer to help keep it active!
- 4. For those people who own a dog(s), please remember to adhere to the following dog rules of Lake Bonnet Village:

Dogs must be on a leash AT ALL TIMES when outside the unit.

Dogs may not disturb residents by barking.

Dogs and cats must be walked DIRECTLY to and from the dog walk area which is on the north side of the road west of the mailboxes.
