FUN CLUB:

BOARD OF DIRECTORS REPORT:

To further streamline the usage of the sewer pump stations we have contracted for on demand generators at two stations; one on Cedarwood which services Redwood and one on Oakwood which pulls from Cedarwood and on to the sewer plant. Long's Air Conditioning from Avon Park will install and service them. Installation is scheduled for March, 2025, well ahead of the hurricane season.

A short history of Glory Park – Traveling back to the year of 1986 when Don White purchased a unit on Cypresswood. Don was a veteran of WWII and service in the Pacific theater. He cleared the brush across the street on Bonnet Lake installing a flag and calling this new park, Glory Park. In 2024 this park further honored all veterans from the five branches of the U.S. military with an addition of a sign and flags. The Beautification Committed has provided the funding.
